## PROUD TO BE YOUR FRIEND

Crimes against lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, inter and queer people (LGBTIQ) have no room in our society.

**In order to build trust and point out that we say NO to any case of hate crime, Schleswig-Holstein Police offer you contact officers for LGBTIQ issues.**

Only if you contact the police criminal offences can be solved or prevented.

## WHY SHOULD I REPORT THE POLICE?

Offenders express their dislike or hatred against LGBTIQ by abusing, offending, beating them in public. They rely on the victim to accept that everyone looks the other way and no charges are filed.

The dark field in the area of homophobic and transphobic offences is thus above average. Help us to lighten up this dark field.

When police are not aware of a crime, we can't take action. Report any offence. Only then we can act at all.

## HOW LONG AFTER THE OFFENCE CAN I CONTACT THE POLICE?

Basically, you can still do this after weeks or months. Restrictions may arise of so-called complaint-offences. However, we are happy to advise you on this.

## CAN I BRING A PERSON I TRUST TO REPORT?

Yes, you can.

## HOW CAN I REPORT AN OFFENCE?

- If you are in an emergency situation, please call the police emergency number "110".
- You can report to any police department.

- You are also welcome to contact us in the LGBTIQ office.

Get in touch with us. We are happy to advise you and, if necessary, get you connected with a victim support project that can offer legal and psychological support. For this, reporting an offence is not absolutely necessary.

## WHAT CAN YOU DO AGAINST HATE CRIME?

### IF YOU FEEL IN DANGER...

- Take your feelings and instincts seriously.
- React immediately and avoid danger.
- Keep distant and avoid physical contact situations.
- Shout and ask for help.
- Call the police in any case.

### WHEN OTHERS ARE IN DANGER OR CALLING FOR HELP...

- Call the police in any case.
- Answer the person who called for help (e.g. "Help is coming, police is called!").
- Help the victim by shouting "Help, Police!"
- Use your voice as a weapon.
- Call other people for assistance.
- Memorize the look of the offender.

### REPORT TO THE POLICE EMERGENCY CALL...

- WHAT happened?
- WHERE did it happen?
- Are there any injured people?
- Number of offenders, if necessary where did they run and how did they look?
- State your location and wait for the police.
